INSTRUCTIONS FOR COMPLETING THE APPLICATION FORM

1. Introduction Type includes seedlings, vegetative propagation materials (cuttings, scions, rootstocks, grafted seedlings, bulbs), forest tree seeds, herbaceous flower seeds, grass stems and seeds, and tissue-cultured plantlets.

2. Quantity Introduced shall be recorded in Arabic numerals followed by Chinese units [e.g., kg, plantlets, seeds, bulbs/tubers, etc.].

3. Production Location denotes the specific production area of imported forestry/grassland seeds and seedlings, requiring: Country name and first-level administrative division (e.g., state/province/county/region for imports from USA, Canada, Russia, Australia).

4. Intended Use covers: afforestation, ornamental purposes, landscape cultivation, soil conservation, grass seeding, biomass feedstock, fruit production, scientific research, exhibitions, and germplasm exchange, etc.

5. Cultivation Site should be specific:

For certified popularization-type quarantine nurseries: Province + County + Township + Village + Nursery Name; For non-quarantine species: "—";

Certification Status Indicates NFGA (National Forestry and Grassland Administration) certification of the nursery.

6. Supplier refers to the foreign entity (enterprise, individual, or institution) directly providing the seeds and seedlings.
